A MONTH THAT WAS...

- ➔ Maharashtra state has invited bids for 500 MW solar power.
- ➔ NASA's giant Webb telescope with a 6.5-meter mirror worth \$10 billion is set to be launched later this year.
- ➔ India has become the fastest nation globally to administer 17 crore (170 Million) doses in 114 days.
- ➔ The Indian Navy has launched operation 'Samudra Setu-II' to bring oxygen-filled cryogenic containers to India from abroad.
- ➔ Centre has decided to waive IGST on import of Covid-relief material received as donation for free distribution.
- ➔ The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) will carry out the civil or construction work for setting up of around 500 medical oxygen plants across districts.
- ➔ The Indian Institute of Science has identified a set of molecular biomarkers that can be used in the differential diagnosis of acute bacterial and viral infections.
- ➔ NICDC Logistics Data Services (NLDS) has extended its services at 9 major Special Economic Zones (SEZ) across India to improve last mile container visibility.
- ➔ The IAF has now clocked over 1,000 sorties by its heavy-lift aircraft like C-17 Globemaster-III and Ilyushin- 76 to transport cryogenic containers and medical equipment from abroad as well as within the country.
- ➔ Fourteen Indian-origin people living in Britain undertook a 116km bike ride across London and raised more than £8,600 (Rs 8.8 lakh) for oxygen concentrators and other life-saving equipment to help India.
