

1. Multipurpose : A type of vessel commonly used to carry project cargo
2. Beam : Width of a ship
3. Hatch : Cover of a ships hold
4. Hold : Area of a ship for stowing cargo
5. Propelled : The P word in SPMT
6. Rigging : The scope that includes Jacking, Sliding, Spotting
7. Landing : The L word in LCT
8. Sling : Nylon webbing used for lashing, securing, and lifting
9. Surveyor : A Master Mariner or Naval Architect who monitors operations on behalf of an insurer, agent, shipper or receiver
10. Ballast : A type of tanks used to adjust the stability of a ship
11. Bollard : A post on a ship or quay used for mooring
12. Thruster : A propulsive device usually located in the bow used for making small adjustments to a ships position
13. Wing : The part of the ship that extends out on either side of the bridge
14. Citadel : A void in the ships hull where crew can seek refuge from pirates
